 - Givebacks to Community \$5,000
 - o 5th Grade committee \$10,000
 - Expect to raise \$63,000 in fundraisers
 - o Plan to spend around \$95,000 for our school and kids
 - There are 430 students
 - Each kid is getting about \$216 of contributions from the PTA
